Nantong promotes electronic health pass ‘Yilaitong’

On 20 February, the reporter learnt from Nantong epidemic prevention and control department social and community prevention and control team conference that from that day Nantong would promote electronic health pass ‘Yilaitong’ all over the city.

There are three steps to apply for ‘Yilaitong’: firstly people scan the QR

code on the notice published in various places to enter the page ‘electronic health pass application’, or follow ‘wechat police’ wechat official accounts of public security departments of various places to apply, and verify with their mobile phone messages. The second step is that after verification is done, people need to fill in personal information, residential information and vehicle, upload their pho-

to, identification card photo and automobile photo, check and fill in relevant information. The third step is that after personal information is registered, the platform will compare information automatically, if everything is correct, a picture of ‘some (county) district some street some community pass’ will be generated, and it can be saved to mobile phone album. The complete progress takes

about 2 to 3 minutes.

Transient people must apply for electronic health pass when they come to Nantong. Resident people can apply for the pass for convenience in entry and exit to public places according to requirements of various places. Nantong police reminded that electronic health pass applies one person one pass, and one time registration. One identification card can only be used in application of one pass, and the pass has a unique code.



On 21 February, a worker was busy in the workshop of Nantong CIMC Energy Co., Ltd. In the present, the company has enough orders and the production line has been started. Up to now all companies of over 100 million Yuan in Gangzha district have started operation.

41 Nantong projects listed in 2020 Jiangsu major projects investment plan Nantong new airport and north riverside high speed railway are on the list

On 19 February, the reporter learnt from Nantong development and reform commission that *2020 Jiangsu major projects list investment plan* was published a few days ago, and there are in total 41 projects related to Nantong. Nantong new airport project which attracted a lot of attention from citizens is listed in reserve projects. North riverside high speed railway is listed in implementation projects.

‘Nantong new airport’ project, as an important part of Shanghai international air hub, is listed in major infrastructure reserve projects. According to planning, Nantong new airport will form ‘an airport on the rail’ together with north riverside high speed railway, and fast access to areas near Shanghai will be realized. In order to promote its implementation, Nantong established new airport (hub) construction headquarters with high standard and is working on preliminary work. North riverside high speed railway as ‘an implementation project’ is also written in *2020 Jiangsu major projects list*. The project involves Nanjing, Yangzhou, Taizhou, Nantong and Suzhou.

Issued force majeure certificates

Nantong trade promotion council recovered about 230 million Yuan loss for companies

To stop the spreading of the epidemic and protect rights of import and export Nantong companies, Nantong trade promotion council applied service companies ‘three no’ work methods: companies have ‘no trouble’ applying for force majeure certificates, ‘no contact’ application and issue of certificates and ‘no stop’ of business legal services. Up to 17 February, Nantong trade promotion council had issued 17 force majeure certificates for 14 companies, and would recover about 230 million Yuan loss for companies.

Nantong trade promotion council proposed companies to apply for certificate of origin self-service printing online, simplified application progress, to make sure that people can get relevant services ‘without going out’. In the present, the self-service printing machines in certificate administration hall are open 24 hours a day and disinfected regularly. After relevant progress is done, Nantong trade promotion council will send certificate documents to companies on the same day of approval, and ‘no contact’ service’ is realized.



On 16 February, at Xingfu technological industrial park in Gangzha district, workers of Jiangsu Youteji sports equipment manufacturing company were busy in the workshop. The products of the company which develops and manufactures optical sights, stools and lighting equipment for outdoor sports shooting are sold to more than 80 countries in the world.
