They have invested 24 projects in Malaysia, and the Chinese side agreed investment amount is 355 million U.S. dollars, involving fields including civil engineering and construction, textile and clothing, communication devices, plastic products, electronic device manufacturing, and furniture manufacturing.

The overall public satisfaction with Nantong ecological environment is 93.7%

Recently, according to 2023 Jiangsu public ecological environment satisfaction survey report published by Jiangsu Bureau of Statistics, several ecological environment evaluation indices of Nantong have increased at varying degrees compared with that of year 2022.

The overall satisfaction with ecological environment has increased 1.9%. *The report* shows that the overall satisfaction of Nantong citizens with the ecological environment has reached 93.7%, and there

is an increase of 1.9 percentage points compared with that of 2022.

Air quality satisfaction rate increased 0.8%. In terms of air quality, the satisfaction rate of Nantong citizens is as high as 92%, which increased 0.8 percentage points compared with that of 2022.

In terms of living environment in Nantong, the satisfaction rate of environmental greening is 93.3%, the satisfaction rate of centralized sewage treatment condition is 82.4%, the satisfaction rate of centralized treatment of household garbage is 87.8%, which all increased compared with that of 2022.

More than 170 overseas Chinese entrepreneurs in Jiebei Village

Jiebei Village is a special village in Tongzhou. It has more than 170 overseas Chinese entrepreneurs, distributed across 20 countries and areas including South Africa, Angola and Ethiopia. In the past few years, Jiebei Village has used the power of overseas Chinese merchants to connect with home textile industry at hometown, and build marketing networks overseas.

Huang Guopei retired in China in last August. 'In the month that I retired, I flew to Angola, to work on relevant matters about the mattress production company. At present the company has already gone into operation officially.' During the online interview, Huang Guopei was busy in the workshop

Huang Guopei was among the

first batch of villagers of Jiebei Village who went abroad. In November 1997, he brought a few containers of cargo, got on an international flight to Eastern Europe, and settled in Romania. After years of development, Huang Guopei's enterprises have been expanded to many countries including Namibia, Angola, and Serbia. In 2004, Huang Guopei went back to his hometown for work. While balancing domestic work and overseas business, he guided and helped many villagers go abroad.

After continuous development, overseas Chinese merchants in Jiebei Village have invested over 50 enterprises abroad, involving several fields such as home textile, construction, real estate and mining.

Huang Yuezhong, the boss of Nantong Thunderbird Textile Co., Ltd., started his overseas business career in Namibia in 2000. Currently he has a few shops at Angola Wholesale Market, which mainly sell bedding textiles. 'In the first few years, my goods were purchased from neighbouring companies. Later I opened a small workshop for self-production and sales.' Huang Yuezhong said that he thought that home textile products also need branding, so he founded a self-owned brand 'Thunderbird' in 2015. 'At present, my brand is very popular in Angola markets. This year the value of goods sent from our state to Angola are estimated to increase 40% compared with that of previous few years.'

At present, there are more than 1500 households and more than 2500 people in Jiebei Village who work in textile product production and processing. 80% of the labor force of the village works in home textile industry, and more than 2000 migrant workers have been attracted here to do business or work.

The first 5G+low altitude private network base station in Nantong opened

On 9th April, Nantong Mobile opened the first low altitude private network base station in the city at Langshan Mountain area, marking the start of building of integrated low altitude flying network in Nantong.

This year, the company will build 20 new 4.9G(4800-4900MHz frequency band)stations in the core city area according to the plan, which will realize the full coverage of low altitude 300 m private network from North Street to Langshan Mountain area. Gu Jun, a Nantong Mobile 5G network technology expert, introduced that the 4.9GHz frequency band 5G private network can ensure the stable signal and less interference between the ground and low altitude. After drones are connected to the network, it can break the distance limit between the pilot and the drone in traditional drone operation, enable long distance control, and provide beyond-line-of-sight flight service, which can effectively expand the application scenarios of '5G+ drone'; including carrying out human flow monitoring at large gatherings and scenic spots.
