Nantong Customs issued a reminder Outbound travellers shall prevent mosquito-borne infectious diseases

Recently, Nantong Customs issued a health reminder, calling on citizens to strengthen prevention of mosquito-borne infectious diseases when travelling abroad. At present, there are a lot of cases of mosquito-borne infectious diseases such as dengue fever, malaria, and chikungunya fever in many places around the world. Imported cases and local transmission have occurred in some parts of China.

Nantong Customs suggested outbound travellers check the epidemic information of the destination in advance. They can inquire at the International Travel Healthcare Center to obtain professional advice. Before travelling, protective items including mosquito re-

pellent and long-lasting mosquito nets shall be prepared. While abroad, they shall avoid going out from dusk to dawn, wear light-colored long-sleeved shirts and pants, choose accommodations with window screens and mosquito nets, and spray pesticides regularly. If you experience symptoms such as fever, headache, joint pain, rash, etc., seek medical attention immediately.

Apart from that, visitors must actively report their travel history and symptoms when entering China and cooperate with customs quarantine. Within the one month after they returned to China, they shall monitor the body temperature closely. If you have suspected symptoms, you need to seek medical treatment immediately and clearly inform the doctor of your overseas trip.



'The first net' of seafood has arrived

At 12:00 on 5th August, more than 300 fishing boats sailed out to Rudong sea area. After dozens of hours of offshore fishing, at about 10 am on 7th August, the first batch of fresh seafood transport vessels berthed at the shore fully loaded with seafood. The port, and the aquatic products trading market became lively again.

'Influenced by previous typhoons, the production of the "first net" this year is slightly less than last year. In particular, the output of golden hook shrimp has decreased significantly.' He Haijun, a shipowner, said with a smile while wiping away sweat. Although the production of 'the first net' is not as expected, the market conditions are pretty good. 'The golden hook shrimp is small in quantity and the price is high, and the current wholesale price per jin is 60 yuan; the swimming crab is relatively affordable, and the price is more than 10 yuan per jin; the small yellow croaker is the most expensive among the catches of this boat, and the price per box is over 1,000 yuan.'

Xu Yun, a citizen who made a special trip, ordered two boxes of swimming crabs and one box of conger eels. 'The elderly and children at home all like them, and I will give some of the extra to friends so everyone can enjoy them together.'

'After the workers finish unloading, the ship will go out immediately, to ensure that it enters and exits one time every day.' Chen Yixing, a shipowner, said.

'Made-in-Nantong' satellites successfully launched

At 18:21 on 4th August, at Hainan Commercial Space Launch Site, a Long March 12 carrier rocket successfully launched the satellite Internet low-orbit 07 satellites, and the satellites successfully entered the designated

orbit. The group of satellites launched this time were all developed by Galaxy Space. This is the first time that a private commercial aerospace company has developed such satellites in batches.

It is worth noting that the group of satellites were all delivered by Galaxy Space Nantong Sat-

ellite Smart Factory. The satellite production lines in the factory have implemented a lot of equipment such as intelligent assembly robots, as well as advanced software platforms such as digital manufacturing systems and automatic comprehensive testing systems. They are implementing mass pro-

duction satellites like mass production cars. More than 100 satellites above 1,000 kg can be produced per year.

Galaxy Space has successfully launched in total more than 30 satellites independently researched, developed and manufactured by the company.
